



Overview

More than 50 SDG indicators, across all 17 goals, have been selected to measure health determinants of health or health-service health-related indicators may be grouped into seven thematic areas:

- reproductive, maternal, newborn and child health
- infectious diseases
- noncommunicable diseases and mental health
- injuries and violence
- universal health coverage and health systems
- environmental risks
- health risks and disease outbreaks.

Available data indicate that despite progress made during the MDG era major challenges remain, including reducing maternal and child mortality, malnutrition, and making further progress in addressing noncommunicable diseases such as HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria, neglected tropical diseases, and mental health.
